The Montgomery Youth Orchestra (MYO) rehearses on Saturdays from 9:45 a.m. until noon at Eastmont Baptist Church, 4505 Atlanta Highway, unless otherwise announced. The group normally performs at least two concerts each season. Membership is open without fee to area students who are selected by audition. Our affiliation with the Alabama Orchestra Association enables MYO members to audition for All-State Orchestra.

The church is not affiliated with the Montgomery Symphony League or the Montgomery Youth Orchestra other than graciously donating rehearsal space. Please do not call the church with any questions or seeking information. Please direct those questions to Mrs. Collins or Mrs. Rawls.

Your involvement and support are important to the success of the MYO. Your most important role is to make sure that your child attends regularly and is on time! We also ask that ACT and SAT testing not be scheduled on the December concert date. We also can use your help when we serve lunch to the students just before the holiday concert, during auditions and before concerts.
